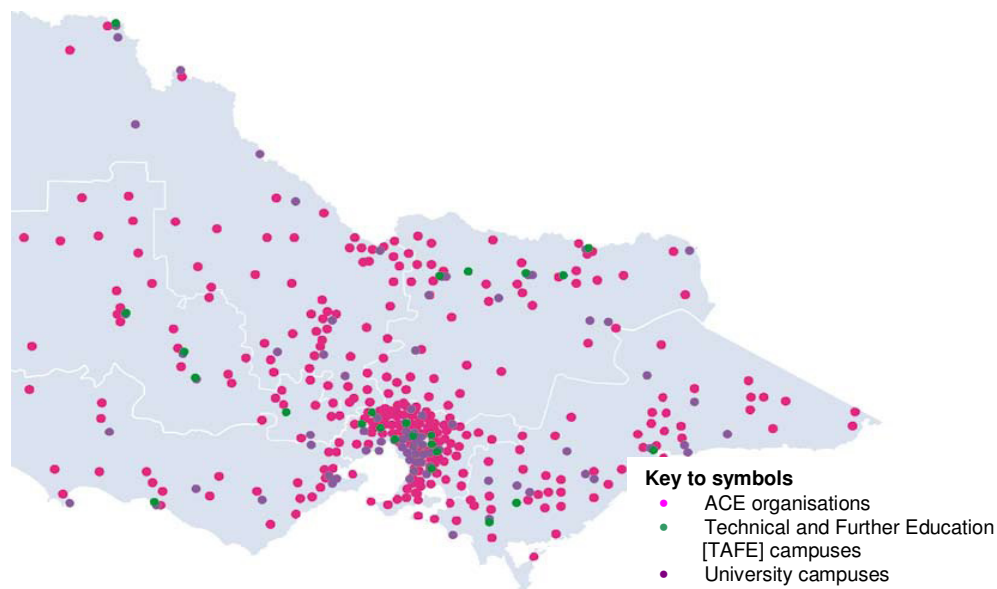

### About ACE

ACE is Adult Community Education. There are currently approx 500 community-managed organisations that deliver adult education programs throughout Victoria. Some run a small amount of entry level classes. Others run a full range of vocational education and training, health and wellbeing and general interest courses and classes.



ACE providers are often the only provider of adult education in small regional and rural towns. The above graphic indicates how important ACE providers are to Victorian communities.

ACEVic is the peak organisation for providers of adult community education in Victoria. Over 190 Victorian ACE providers are members of ACEVic. ACEVic was established in 1975 and became incorporated in 1988.

### About the “One Vision One Voice” Conference
